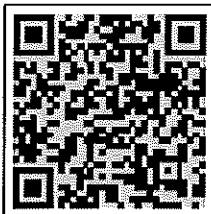

THE SEASON AFTER *Pentecost*

Red is the color used on Pentecost Sunday. On this day we remember the power and fire of the Holy Spirit, "the Lord and Giver of Life." The color red communicates the motif of strength – the strength and power the Holy Spirit gives in order for God's people to call on the name of Jesus Christ and share that powerful name with others.

Pentecost begins fifty days after Easter. The season of Pentecost may last from 22 to 28 Sundays. **Green** is the appointed color for all but a few of these Sundays. The Sundays following Pentecost are called the season of the "green meadow," as these Sundays also emphasize the subject of growth.

Pastor Mark's Remarks for August 2026***"Culture eats strategy for breakfast"***

Do not conform to the pattern of this world but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. Romans 12:2

A quote attributed to Peter Drucker, but which likely originated with Edgar Schein is that "culture eats strategy for breakfast." We can brainstorm and come up with new programs and strategies until the cows come home, but if our strategies are contrary to our culture, they will likely not succeed.

Jesus didn't come to share new strategies or programs. He came to invite people into a whole new culture, a whole new paradigm for seeing God, ourselves, our neighbor and the world. That new culture he called "The Kingdom of God." The ones who learned to live in that culture received what Jesus came to bring, and the ones who were stuck in their own worldviews either ignored or rejected him.

For eight Sundays beginning August 23, I will be preaching a sermon series focused, not on programs or strategies, but on aligning ourselves with the Kingdom of God. I will be using the book *The War of Worldviews* by Jamie Winship as a resource for those who want to do more reading on the things I will be preaching about.

In a world of individualism, fear, scarcity, canceling and separation, Jesus invites us into a community of connection, love, abundance, forgiveness and empowerment. It is only as we learn to live in his culture that our programs and strategies will start making a difference in the world.

If culture eats strategy for breakfast, may we learn to live in a culture that not only doesn't eat up the effectiveness of our ministries for breakfast, but actually multiplies our efforts to bless the world around us.

Some Notes about Worship in August

- We will be using a simplified order of worship for the next couple of months as we decide which setting to do next in the fall.
- Pastor Mark will be preaching a series about the culture of God's Kingdom starting Sunday, August 23. If you want to go deeper in what he is preaching on, you are invited to get a copy of the book *The War of Worldviews* by Jamie Winship. You can get it through Amazon, Barnes and Nobel and Mardel. If you want the church to order a copy, the cost will be about \$15, and the order will be sent on Monday, August 17.

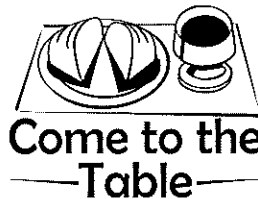
**Men's Group in August – Saturday, August 15 at 6:30**

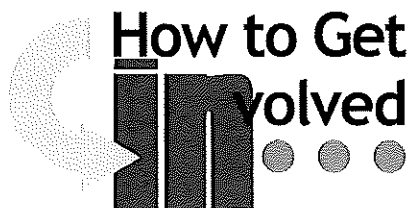

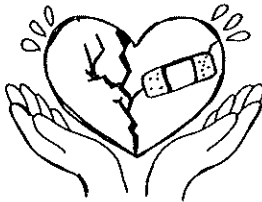
