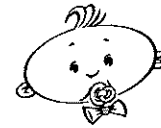

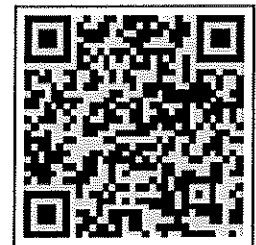

Pastor Mark's Remarks for April 2026***"Freed to Live, not just to avoid dying"***

"Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you." Matthew 28:7

We don't honor those who fought for our country by remembering their suffering but not living out the freedom and opportunity they paid for with that suffering.

A good marriage is not just celebrating you are not single anymore. It is living in the fullness of what it means to be together.

In the same way, a good steward of what Jesus paid for on the cross does not just focus on what they have been freed from, but they also seek to fully live out what they have been freed for.

When the women come to the tomb on Easter morning, the angels' message to them is not just that Jesus isn't dead, but that he is going ahead of them to continue to be with them in what is coming next.

A Christianity that is fixated only on what we have been freed from without moving us to live out what we have been freed for, is poorly stewarded Christianity.

Jesus, may I not just honor you by being grateful for what you freed me from. May I truly honor you by fully living out what you have freed me for. AMEN

LifeWise Bible Classes in Yukon and Mustang Schools

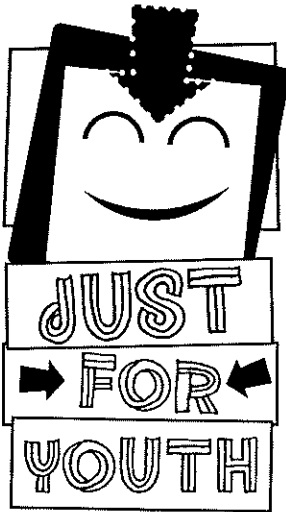

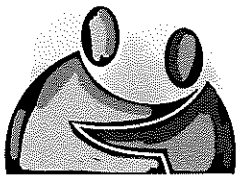
