Easter: April 20

White is used during Easter and assists in bearing the message that "though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be white as snow." Christ's triumph from the grave on Resurrection Day is the cause for our rejoicing. His purity before his Father becomes our purity. White reinforces that message of joy.

Easter falls on a different Sunday each year. Why is that? According to the Gregorian calendar, Easter must be the first Sunday after the March equinox (or the first full moon after the first day of spring). The Orthodox churches use the Julian rather than the Gregorian calendar, which causes the dates of Easter to differ in Eastern and Western churches.

"What we believe is measured by what we do"

²⁴"[Jesus said] Everyone then who hears these words of mine and acts on them will be like a wise man who built his house on rock. ²⁵The rain fell, the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on rock. ²⁶And everyone who hears these words of mine and does not act on them will be like a foolish man who built his house on sand. ²⁷The rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell—and great was its fall!"

Matthew 7:24-27

It is great to believe what Jesus teaches in the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7), but we will only be blessed by his teaching if we do what he says and not just hear it.

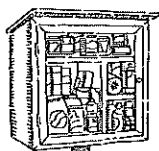
I can hear my doctor say, "You need to eat better," but I am only blessed by hearing those words if I do what the doctor says.

I can hear my boss say, "You will get a bonus if you accomplish these work goals" but I will only get the bonus if I do what the boss says and not just hear the words.

I can hear lots of great sermons about living the Christian life, but I will be blessed by none of them if all I do is hear the words. I will only be blessed by them when I live according to the words I have heard.

Faith that is not willing to act on what it says it believes is not really faith. A much better measurement for faith than simply listing intellectual beliefs is seeing what we actually do.

Father, I call you my provider, but I too often live as though my provision is completely dependent on me. I call you my protector, but I often live life in fear and don't take the risk of doing what you are calling me to do. I call you my Lord, but often choose to veto what you are saying so I can do things my way. Help me to start having my actions more fully match what I claim to believe. AMEN
