Easter Season 2025 **April 20 - June 1**

White is used during Easter and assists in bearing the message that "though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be white as snow." Christ's triumph from the grave on Resurrection Day is the cause for our rejoicing. His purity before his Father becomes our purity. White reinforces that message of joy.

Easter falls on a different Sunday each year. Why is that? According to the Gregorian calendar, Easter must be the first Sunday after the March equinox (or the first full moon after the first day of spring). The Orthodox churches use the Julian rather than the Gregorian calendar, which causes the dates of Easter to differ in Eastern and

*Pastor Mark's Remarks for May 2025**"Being sent like Jesus"*

Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you."

John 20:21

Being sent into the world as the Father sent Jesus is about connections. Jesus was fully connected to the Father he came to reveal and fully connected to the world he came to serve. Any Christianity which is disconnected from the Father or disengaged from the world is not a Christianity which looks like Jesus.

Jesus went off regularly for quiet time with his Father. He told his disciples that he only did what he saw his Father doing and only said what he heard his Father saying. He even went as far as saying that seeing him was seeing the Father. If we are sent like Jesus, we need to have healthy connection to the Father so we can know and join in with what he is doing and saying.

Jesus spent much of his time ministering to people. He came to seek and save the lost, he came to set prisoners free and heal the sick, he called himself the Good Shepherd who laid down his life for his sheep. If we are sent like Jesus, we need to be engaged in loving and serving those around us. Both those who already know Jesus and those who don't. Both our friends and our enemies.

When I make my Christianity about getting from God without giving away to others, my Christianity is sick.

When I make my Christianity about giving away to others without receiving what God wants to give me, my Christianity is sick.

When I have no connection with God or my neighbor, my Christianity is more than sick. It is dead.

A Christianity which looks like Jesus has intimacy with the Father and engagement in serving the world. That is the Christianity that is not sick, but healthy. That is not dead, but alive.
